2000 Chateau de Montfaucon Red **** 4 stars

“A better-than-average Côtes du Rhône from an excellent vintage and a smallish producer based near Chateauneuf-du-Pape. The winemaker, Rodolphe de Pins, has worked at Henschke in the Eden Valley... This gentle light-to medium-bodied red is a blend of grenache, mourvedre, syrah and carignan, with ripe red berry and spicy, herby aromas and raspberry, red plum and cedar flavours. Expect its savoury notes to kick in when consumed with a beef or lamb stew.”

« De Pins is well known in the Australian wine industry, not only for visiting us to exhibit his Chateau de Montfaucon wines, but for also doing a vintage at Henschke in the Barossa in 1992. His wines are available here in varying quantities and their prices, when compared with the escalating cost of some Rhône Wines, represent excellent value. »
